SUMMARY OF THE THIRD MEETING DCTEST PROJECT

The third meeting took place in Arezzo (Italy) on 27-28 September 2016 and it was hosted by Arezzo Innovazione. The meeting focused on the e-learning training and pedagogical material. That means the Intellectual outputs IO3 (training of trainers) and IO4 (training for learners). The team discussed the schedule of the course, the involvement of teachers and the content of learners training.

Date and place chosen for the fourth meeting: 14-15 March 2017 in Wilhelmshaven (Germany)

Training of trainers in Digital Competences (IO3)

The course is already started in Spain and it will begin in January in the rest of partner countries (Germany, United Kingdom, Italy, Greece and Turkey) until the end of March.

The training is divided in 5 modules and it has a length of 80 hours of online and offline work. The trainers will have a their disposal pedagogical contents, bibliography and the support of a tutor to create their own training materials. Self-assessments templates to evaluate initial and final knowledge of participants are also available online.



TRAINING COURSE IN DIGITAL COMPETENCES FOR LEARNERS (IO4)

The course will have 3 different levels (basic, intermediate and advance) and it will be divided in 5 competences modules with a duration of between 25-27 hours: information and filtering; communication; content design, safety and problem solving. A certificate will be provided to all the students who complete the training. It is expected the course to be start in February 2017.
